Another part of the autumn was accompanied by a number of small workshops, and most importantly, the preparation of presentation Bosco per la Biosfera for primary school.



Too in December I joined to the project «Bosco Breniolo». The goal of this project is to plant oaks in the park Bosco Breniolo.



One of the most interesting moment started in the middle of January. We started the Blue Garden project, which was to create an eco-territory for future activities with schoolchildren.



The park was opened on January 25. There was an action with the cutting of the tape and speech of the politicians of the Commune of Mascali. After volunteers and partners of Giacche Verdi presented a series of workshops for 200 primary school children of Mascali.



The rest of the project Bosco per la Biosfera we continued to work at school and outside through a variety of workshops and activities with children.
